**Re: Planning application for erection of shed at 36 Ennor Close, Old Town, St Mary's –
Mr & Mrs R Edwards**

We are writing to support our application for a 10' x 8' apex shed in the front garden of 36 Ennor Close which we have just recently moved into.

We are both in our eighties and my husband is registered disabled. He currently uses a mobility scooter which he relies on heavily to get him around. I am due to have a hip replacement next month and will be getting an additional scooter as I won't be able to drive for at least 12 weeks. The proposed shed will house both scooters to keep them away from the elements, as well as a freezer and a tumble dryer, which I am unable to fit into the bungalow.

There is a gateway to the neighbouring property (No 12) which will be concealed if the shed is erected. Cornwall Rural Housing Association, who are our landlord, did confirm that there is no legal access or right of way into the property, so the gateway shouldn't affect the application.
