## Section 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990: Notification of Works to Trees in a Conservation Area

**REFERENCE:** P/20/007/TWA  
**WORKS PROPOSED:** Crown lift and removal of dead wood to a large number of Elms, where overhanging the road they will require some rebalancing and crown lift and removal of deadwood from trees overhanging buildings.  
**LOCATION:** Land At Junction Of Rocky Hill Lane/Porthloo Lane  
Porthloo Lane, St Mary's, Isles of Scilly

Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 6<sup>th</sup> February 2020. Following a site visit I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works. Whilst the trees hold high amenity value it is considered that the proposed works are appropriate. The Council do not intend to protect these trees further through a Tree Preservation Order (TPO).

If the works are not executed within two years of the date of this letter you are required to notify the Council's Planning Department again of your intention to undertake work to the trees. The work could be carried out in accordance with good practice as set out in "British Standards Recommendation for Tree Work" BS3998.
