## Comments:

Thank you for consulting us on this application. We have consulted the Cornwall & Isles of Scilly Historic Environment Record and the submitted Heritage Impact Assessment. The latter is deficient in not including the Listed Building Wahroonga (DCO14271), which lies 65m to the east of the proposal, and does not itemise the non-designated assets, which include the former fire station (MCO54347) and various findspots, all of which go some way to allowing an assessment of the archaeological potential of the area. However, in this instance, given the limited footprint of the proposal in terms of area and depth, we consider it unlikely that significant archaeological remains will be disturbed by groundworks. No archaeological mitigation is required, and therefore no archaeological condition is sought.
