Scheduled Monument

There is one scheduled monument 127m from the proposed site. However, the proposed solar canopy will not have an impact on the scheduled monument as it is sufficient distance away and nestled within buildings on the school site.

Archeological Constraints and Find Spots

The archeological constraint areas are sufficient distance away from the site and will not be impacted. There is one find spot in the vicinity of the proposed site which is a pivot stone found in 1993 built into the hedge on the road leading down to Carn Gwaval Base and Five Islands Academy. There are no find spots on the proposed site which is within that parking areas of the school site.
