#### Archeological Constraints and Find Spots

The archeological constraint areas are sufficient distance away from the site and will not be impacted. There is one find spot in the vicinity of the proposed site which is a pivot stone found in 1993 built into the hedge on the road leading down to Carn Gwavel Base and Five Islands Academy. There are no find spots on the proposed site which is within that parking areas of the school site.
