Dear Sir,

I write with reference to the above planning application to install electric charging points at the bottom of the hill on Parsons Field.

I wish to object on the following grounds:

1. It doesn't seem appropriate for the Planning Department of the Isles of Scilly to make a decision on an application from the Isles of Scilly Council.
2. As the bays can only be used to charge electric vehicles, this will greatly reduce the already limited number of spaces available for local residents and shoppers.
3. As there is the potential for queues to form to use these charging points, it is not sensible to install them near what is already a busy junction/turning point for private and commercial vehicles.

Would it not make sense to install the charging points at commercial sites (e.g. at Sibleys or on the Porthmellon Trading Estate) or increase the number of charging points at Carn Thomas?
