We wish to make representation against the practical use, financial cost & health/safety implications/use of electric charging points x 3 spaces being installed in the Mermaid carpark.

We own Pilots gig flat & have already suffered damage to the roof of our property due to an Island carriers driver/vehicle misjudging the tight corner due to a car being parked in the space closest to Tregarthens hotel steps & our property, thus hindering his turn. This was costly & although not intentional was a direct result of the limited space for vehicles on that corner. It is dangerous corner.

This location is badly affected by high tides & suffers storm damage. The costly nature of electric charging points in this location seems to be ill thought out. The further reduction of general use parking spaces also seems to only further exacerbate the potential for accidents with other vehicles or pedestrians ( there is no pavement) in this area on this already vulnerable corner.

The other locations proposed for charging points in Hugh town are more suitable & accessible for more users.
