I would like to object to this proposed structure on the grounds that it will reduce the already limited parking space used for town and in particular people working on off islands.

In the summer if you don't get to the Mermaid car park before 08:00hrs then all available spaces have been taken, and when working on an off island the harbour master does not allow parking on the quay which means that I have to drive down the quay, unload my tools and materials onto the quay and leave them there, then go and find a parking space, which is sometimes over 500m away up by the museum, then I have to walk to the quay before boarding a boat to be able to do my job.

On returning to St Mary's I then have to repeat the process in return, this is something that I can brought to the attention of the council on a number of occasions.

The lack of parking in the Mermaid carpark can add an additional 1k of road traffic Reducing the parking spaces further is not going to help this situation in any way And whatever structure is built will last a winter before rusting away
