## Heritage Impact Assessment – Installation of and Electric Vehicle Charging Points at:

### Site 21, Telegraph

#### Listed Buildings

There is one listed building within the vicinity of the proposed charge point installation, Coastguard's Lookout Tower which is Grade II listed. The proposed charging point is on the opposite side of the road to the Lookout Tower in a layby which is already used for parking and will not alter the context in which the listed building is seen.

#### Scheduled Monument

There are no Scheduled Monuments within the vicinity of the proposed development.

#### Non-designated Heritage Assets

Telegraph Road Neolithic standing stone is listed next to the Lookout Tower listed above. As with the Tower, the proposed charging point is on the opposite side of the road in a layby which is already used for parking and will not alter the context in which the listed building is seen.

To the West of the proposed site there are three historic find spots, TELEGRAPH HILL - Prehistoric findspot, CARN MORVAL DOWN - Bronze Age cist and TELEGRAPH HILL - Prehistoric findspot. The find spots are situated away from the charge points locations behind the buildings on Telegraph road and will not be affected by the proposal.
