We were dissapointed to be advised of yet another planning application for the GARDEN of the above property.

We have the following concerns relating to the application -

- 1. A few years ago there was a meeting relating to the woeful state of the disposal of our sewerage, which did not meet with current regulations. Nothing has happened to improve the situation[as far as we know]. Surely before granting more development the sewerage concerns should be addressed and if there must be more development it should be for local needs.
- 2. We do think that in general having access for the disabled is a good idea, but having arrived on St Marys, the other islands are inaccessible so they will be unable to explore any further.
- 3. It will be very upsetting to see this green oasis in the town disappear, particularly for the wildlife that call it home.
