Section 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990: Notification of Works to Trees in a Conservation Area

REFERENCE: P/20/057/TWA

WORKS PROPOSED: Pollarding including crown lifting and reducing of 10 no

trees: 4 x Elm and 1 x Sweet Chestnut in the garden/boundary of 34 Ennor Close and 5 x Elm on

the footpath behind the garages.

LOCATION: Ennor Close, Old Town St Mary's Isles of Scilly

Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 4th August 2020. Following a site visit I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works. Whilst the trees hold good amenity value it is considered that the proposed works are appropriate. The Council do not intend to protect this tree further through a Tree Preservation Order (TPO).

If the works are not executed within two years of the date of this letter you are required to notify the Council's Planning Department again of your intention to undertake work to the tree(s). The work could be carried out in accordance with good practice as set out in "British Standards Recommendation for Tree Work" BS3998.
