## Section 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990: Notification of Works to Trees in a Conservation Area

**REFERENCE:**

P/20/059/TWA

**WORKS PROPOSED:**

Fell large Leylandii due to excessive shading causing damp issues and falling branches causing damage to the properties known as the White House and Spindrift and roots pushing out boundary wall and possible future damage to a retaining wall.

**LOCATION:**

White House, The Garrison, St Mary's

Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 10<sup>th</sup> August 2020. Following a site visit I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works. The tree holds limited amenity value and overall it is considered that the proposed tree removal is acceptable. The Council do not intend to protect this tree further through a Tree Preservation Order (TPO).

If the works are not executed within two years of the date of this letter you are required to notify the Council's Planning Department again of your intention to undertake work to the tree(s). The work could be carried out in accordance with good practice as set out in "British Standards Recommendation for Tree Work" BS3998.
