Section 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990: Notification of Works to Trees in a Conservation Area

REFERENCE: P/20/074/TWA
WORKS PROPOSED: Works to 5 no. *Macrocarpa Lutea* (Monterey Cypress) including crown reduction, dead wooding and removal of dangerous branches.
LOCATION: The New House, Higher Town, St Martins Isles of Scilly

Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 21st September 2020. I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works.
