



### Introduction

1. The purpose of this document is to support the planning application which seeks permission to repaint 19-22 Ennor Close

### **Proposed Site**

2. The proposed site is located at 19-22 Ennor Close, St Mary's, Isles of Scilly. Situated in the housing estate of Ennor Close in Old Town, St Mary's, Isles of Scilly.
