Section 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990: Notification of Works to Trees in a Conservation Area

WORKS PROPOSED: Removal of one Sycamore tree before it causes

damage to the soak away system and neighbour's

garage roof.

LOCATION: High Pines, McFarlands Down, St Mary's Isles of Scilly

Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 15th March 2021. I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works. Whilst the tree holds some amenity value it is considered that the proposed tree removal is acceptable. The Council do not intend to protect this tree further through a Tree Preservation Order (TPO).

If the works are not executed within two years of the date of this letter you are required to notify the Council's Planning Department again of your intention to undertake work to the tree. The work should be carried out in accordance with good practice as set out in "British Standards Recommendation for Tree Work" BS3998.
