Environment Agency Position

Taking into account the IOS model outputs and the flood statement, we have no objection to this development.

Reason

For present day, the site falls within FZ1. Looking at the 1:200 cc outputs, part of the site (including the north west part of the proposed development) will be at flood risk (the depths of <0.25m). The 1:200 cc level is proposed to be 4.90mOAD and with the proposed floor levels of 6.5mOAD I am happy that these are raised up appropriately. Access /Egress is expected to remain dry / FZ1 (now and with CC).

Advice to LPA

As mentioned by the applicant, the plot is semi exposed. We would recommend an assessment of potential erosion / reference to the Shoreline Management Plan. This would not be our remit to comment on however, and would be down to the council.
