But I cannot sustain in this current situation where by in one hand I am lible to the councils circa per annum the sum of £4,147.20 whilst at the same time trying to Lollow my councils planning polices. and then at the sametime be expected to follow a policy which appears to be very difficult if not impossible to follow.
