## Section 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990: Notification of Works to Trees in a Conservation Area

<b>REFERENCE:</b>	P/21/040TWA
<b>WORKS PROPOSED:</b>	Removal of a Scots Pine and the crown reduction of a <i>Metrosideros</i> tree.
<b>LOCATION:</b>	Pelorus, Church Road, Hugh Town St Mary's Isles of Scilly TR21 0NA

Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 18<sup>th</sup> May 2021. I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works. Whilst the trees hold some amenity value it is considered that the proposed works are appropriate. The Council do not intend to protect these trees further through a Tree Preservation Order (TPO).

If the works are not executed within two years of the date of this letter you are required to notify the Council's Planning Department again of your intention to undertake work to the trees.
