Re the re- presentation of the above planning application to the Isles of Scilly Council Planning Committee, I wish to reinforce my objection to this scheme in the strongest possible terms. I agree with all the other submitted objections against proceeding with this plan: where does one start? Lack of detail, confusing plans, strange cut'n'paste photos not to scale, concerns over infrastructure, local needs, environment, heritage, coastal erosion etc. Clearly these objections have all been very well researched and assembled with great care. In all the correspondence, any revelation of a direct impassioned response has, I'm sure, been tempered to avoid counter objections by the planners of NIMBY thinking. However, I suspect that, like me, fellow objectors, including those who have not written to you, are all frankly incredulous that this absurd scheme to plonk some Toy Town fake cottages on such a beautiful headland ever got this far. I object to this and any future schemes to build on Porthcressa, Buzza Hill and the coastal path, and I strongly advise the Planning Committee to dismiss this application out of hand.
