Thank you for consulting us on this application. We have consulted the Cornwall & Isles of Scilly Historic Environment Record, and while there is a record of a granite mortar in the former garden of Kenyhton (MCO30710), the site was extensively redeveloped in 2017 with the construction of Island Fish. Modern Ordnance Survey mapping and analysis of recent aerial photographs also suggests there has been some ground disturbance in the vicinity of the proposed extension. Therefore, in this instance, we consider it unlikely that significant archaeological remains will be disturbed by groundworks. No archaeological mitigation is required, and therefore no archaeological condition is sought.
