Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 14<sup>th</sup> October 2021. I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works. Whilst the tree holds good amenity value it is considered that the proposed tree removal is, in this case, acceptable. The Council do not intend to protect this tree further through a Tree Preservation Order (TPO).

If the works are not executed within two years of the date of this letter you are required to notify the Council's Planning Department again of your intention to undertake work to the trees.
