Thank you for the attached, this has been received by the business and I can confirm that South West Water can very cautiously support this request to connect to the public water network as it relates to very specific local arrangements/conditions. The applicant should liaise directly with South West Water regarding the detail of this connection.

All requests are considered on a case by case basis, Its really only exceptional cases like this where the request is for an existing customer and for an extension to a very low consumption supply where we can support the application.

South West Water would like to see water saving features where possible in this development to protect water resources.

As part of South West Water's strategy to improve the drinking water and waste water infrastructure on the islands an investment programme has been developed which will be focused on achieving a reliable wastewater service including being able to cope with extreme conditions, protecting the environment and providing long term benefits to the community with the Company committed to support the necessary improvements in water and wastewater services on the islands so that services are in line with standards on mainland UK by 2025 or 2030 in the case of Tresco. This includes the ability to provide new water and sewer connections to the network and therefore it is recommended that the applicant liaises directly with the Company to discuss the potential of connections to public assets.

We have three planning applications in at the moment that are proposing a new shepherds huts on sites across the island of St Martins.
