This will inevitably have a detrimental effect on her business (which I have no invested interest in whatsoever) So why take his frustration out on this business?

So, I think this just about wraps it up as far as I'm concerned. Going back to the original letter I wrote, if it can't be placed somewhere more "sympathetic", and the council grant permission to let it go ahead, then I will live with it obviously!
