Dear Sir, Madam,

My wife and I would like to object to the renewed planning application P/20/104-105-106/FUL In regards to Sea View, McFarlands Down, St. Mary's, Isles of Scilly, TR21 ONS.

It seems that there have not been any alterations to the new application that would materially satisfy the previous objections made by the council in its refusal of permission for development dated 16.12 2000.

It still represents an over-development on this site contrary to Policy 1(c) of the Isles of Scilly local plan 2005. It is still out of scale with the developments in the area and would represent a development discordant of the buildings on McFarland Down.

The development would still result in loss of green space and biodiversity habitat.

Just by rotating P/29/105/FU , the middle building around by 180 degrees and some minor changes to the plan none of the objections of the Refusal of Permission 2020 have been satisfied and therefore the new plans do not preserve or enhance the character of the conservation area.

We would like to suggest planning for 2 dwellings instead of the 3 in the new application. Also a reduction of height would make the plan more acceptable to us and residents of McFarland Down.
