Section 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990: Notification of Works to Trees in a Conservation Area

**REFERENCE**: P/22/013/TWA

WORKS PROPOSED: To de-limb a large Monterey pine tree back to the

trunk which will be left at a height of 2-2.5m. The tree is causing damage to the boardwalk and path

due to having a lack of root plate and will

eventually fall.

**LOCATION:** Higher Moors Nature Trail, Porth Hellick, St

Mary's

Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 24<sup>th</sup> January 2022. I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works. Whilst the tree holds good amenity value it is considered that the proposed works are appropriate. The Council do not intend to protect this tree further through a Tree Preservation Order (TPO).

If the works are not executed within two years of the date of this letter you are required to notify the Council's Planning Department again of your intention to undertake work to the tree. The work could be carried out in accordance with good practice as set out in "British Standards Recommendation for Tree Work" BS3998.
