We have consulted the Cornwall & Isles of Scilly Historic Environment Record in conjunction with the submitted Heritage Statement (Nick Collins April 2022) and Design and Access Statement (Purcell 2022) in relation to the proposed alteration and extension of the Grade II Listed Town Hall (NHLE 1219066).
