The proposed new additions appear to vastly overshadow not only the Town Hall building itself, but also Parade Cottage next to it, both of which are buildings of historical interest. I feel that if these plans were to be approved it would have a seriously detrimental affect on the look of the town itself as this small area is the 'town centre', and nothing else in the surrounding area has such an industrial or modern look to it. In my personal opinion, I think these plans should be refused.
