My only real observation is that the northerly elevation stretches the imagination fully in an attempt to see how it does the surrounding buildings and whole area justice. I have less concern with regard to the southerly elevations as anything would arguably be an improvement but am convinced, that with a little more imagination, the northerly or front facing elevation could be dramatically improved and could sit far more comfortably within the existing environment.
