Thank you for consulting us on this application. We note our advice to the LPA regarding P/19/060 and P/19/059, both in relation to St Martin's Vineyard, Higher Town, St Martin's. P/19/059 associated with the two shepherd huts and P/19/060, for the staff accommodation building (for which P/22/048/FUL is relevant).

We also note our advice regarding both these applications provided on 24th October 2019, resulting in decision notices of P/19/059 and P/19/060 containing no requirement for archaeological recording during groundworks as part of conditional consent.

Therefore, in regard to P/22/048/FUL no archaeological mitigation is required, and therefore no archaeological condition is sought.
