
Flood Risk Assessment

For Temporary Accommodation Units @ Stoneyard, Moor Well Lane, Porth Mellon, St Mary's

We recognise that the site location known as the Stoneyard at Porth Mellon on St Mary's is within Flood Zone 2/3, see attached Flood Map For Planning. As such the following measures will be undertaken in respect of the installation of temporary accommodation units for the construction workers engaged in the construction of the Climate Adaption Scillies – Coastal Defence project, part funded by The Environment Agency.

- All portable accommodation units, including the canteen unit will be established in a raised setting approx. 600mm above existing ground level and will be accessed by steps.
- 2. Two sealed sewerage holding tanks will be placed at ground level, with plumbing from the units connected by gravity. These tanks measure approx. 3m x 4m and 0.6m high.

The above measures reduce the impact of the temporary development on the flood profile, resulting in a displacement of circa. 14.5m³ flood capacity on the existing site.


