Details of the pre-application advice received

There are a significant number of windows on the property and from what I can see the existing windows and approved windows are generally for white UPVC. To change the colour we are assuming that you would need to replace the whole window units (as opposed to just painting timber frames for example) in which case this in itself would require planning permission which is standard where the design, style or colour is changing. Whilst this could be dealt with as a variation to the existing permission, it isn't clear whether all the windows were originally proposed to be replaced so it would be cleaner to apply for planning permission to replace the windows on the whole property.

So in short, we would be looking at a new application for planning permission to cover the whole property and with this we would be considering the appearance and character of the building and area including the nearby scheduled monument (Garrison Walls). Obviously the windows if UPVC already could be replaced on a like for like basis without planning permission but I think it would be the significant colour change compared to all the surrounding buildings that we would be considering the most.
