Yes we have had an objection from HE of which identifies the issue that also concerns us, the further impact upon the Garrison Wall, so it is currently down to be refused. I am happy to consider further information if you think there are wider public benefits to the harm identified but, as you note, there is little time to reconsult on further information.

It does also raise the question of 'accessibility' as I had understood the end unit was single level accommodation and suitable for anyone with mobility problems? So it is a little confusing to have the upper floor accommodation now included which would seem to preclude occupation by a mobility impaired guest?
