It has been said that there is no evidence that overtopping into Great Pool effects the salinity of ground water. I can state categorically that it does not. Overtopping into Water Meadow does effect the ground water - it pollutes the well, and I was pleased that agreement to reinstate Popplestones leet was reached, and this should be carried over to any new or revised plans. Proper consultation with the Island should be held to properly identify the areas that need to be considered and how we can best achieve protection with minimal impact
