We remove our objection to this development

I can confirm that the arrangement for the Geobag shown in drawings DKR6499-110-D310 rev 03 and DKR6499-110-D110 Rev 03 is in line with the recommendations given in our original response to the application.

Reasons

Our comments about the proposed ridge profile and height remain, but these will not now have an impact on the Geobag structure, given its set back location. This may result in the exposure of the geomat at the seaward edge overtime. However, this should not in itself impact on the function of the structure or significantly influence the behaviour of the dune/shingle ridge.
