#### Waste

Any waste should be securely stored within the boundary of the property and placed out on the highway on the appointed day of collection. The plans should include the provision of secure waste and recycling storage within the boundary of the property, taking into account both current and future waste and segregated recycling requirements laid out in the Government's Environment Act. The provision of waste and recycling storage should be of sufficient size as to accommodate segregated black bag/cardboard and dry mixed recycling with enough capacity to extend as and when increased segregation is introduced.

Any waste derived from the proposed alterations would become commercial if contractors are carrying out the works and as such would require a commercial waste site permit to enter the Porthmellon Waste and Recycling facility during commercial opening times with the relevant disposal fee being charged
