# **Site Description and Proposed Development**

Demelza is a detached residential dwelling and is the southern most property on the east side of Jacksons Hill. The property overlooks the Porthmellon Waste Site and the land slopes down to the east backing on to Moorwell Lane with gated access directly to the garden.

The garden where it borders Moorwell Lane is lined with a screen of mature elm and sycamore trees. Inside this is a line of 12 no. mature leylandii trees. The proposal is to fell and remove the leylandii trees as they are blocking light to the property and reducing the available amenity space.

**Analysis:** The trees are protected by the Conservation Area designation which covers the entire Isles of Scilly. Prior to any person undertaking tree pruning or felling works they are required to serve Notice 211 on the Council, allowing 6 weeks notification of any tree works to be carried out. This allows sufficient time for the Local Planning Authority to assess the appropriateness of the works proposed and determine whether a Tree Preservation Order (TPO) is required, that would essentially permit the use of restrictive conditions on any works proposed. It also ensures that adequate (and qualified) justification is submitted to support the works, particularly in cases of tree removal, where the works are deemed to have harmful impact upon the amenity value they hold and any importance to the character of the conservation area.

The 12 leylandii trees are said to have grown to a height where they will not survive and re-grow from more vigorous pruning works hence the proposal to completely remove them. They are not considered to hold a high amenity value to the wider area as they are only really visible from within the site. The garden cannot be readily seen from the Jacksons Hill side and the elms and sycamores dominate the view from Moorwell Lane as you walk through meaning the leylandii trees aren't noticeable.

From the photos submitted, the trees do look to dominate the garden as stated. It is not felt that the removal of these trees will harm the wider conservation area and that their removal will improve the residential amenity of the dwelling and improve light.
