Please find below SWW response in relation to this planning application.

In relation to the a connection to the drinking water network South West Water is able to support connection for this proposal. The applicant should liaise directly with South West Water regarding the detail of this connection.

South West Water is able to support foul only connections for this proposal. The applicant should liaise directly with South West Water regarding the detail of this connection. Capacity within the foul sewerage system is currently restricted and therefore individual connections are considered on a case by case basis. Any connection to the sewerage system will therefore be subject to the agreement of SWW in respect of both the timing and point of connection.

Surface Water Services

The applicant should demonstrate to your LPA that its prospective surface run-off will discharge as high up the hierarchy of drainage options as is reasonably practicable (with evidence that the Run-off Destination Hierarchy has been addressed, and reasoning as to why any preferred disposal route is not reasonably practicable):

- 1. Discharge into the ground (infiltration); or where not reasonably practicable,
- 2. Discharge to a surface waterbody; or where not reasonably practicable,
- 3. Discharge to a surface water sewer, highway drain, or another drainage system; or where not reasonably practicable,
- 4. Discharge to a combined sewer.(Subject to Sewerage Undertaker carrying out capacity evaluation)

Having reviewed the applicant's current information as to proposed surface water disposal for its development, please note that method proposed to discharge into the main sewer is **not** acceptable and does not meet with the Run-off Destination Hierarchy. South West Water will need to see the evidence as to why the proposal cannot discharge higher up the hierarchy.

As part of South West Water's strategy to improve the drinking water and waste water infrastructure on the islands an investment programme has been developed which will be focused on achieving a reliable wastewater service including being able to cope with extreme conditions, protecting the environment and providing long term benefits to the community with the Company committed to support the necessary improvements in water and wastewater services on the islands so that services are in line with standards on mainland UK by 2025 or 2030 in the case of Tresco. This includes the ability to provide new water and sewer connections to the network and therefore it is recommended that the applicant liaises directly with the Company to discuss the potential of connections to public assets.
