The flood assessment submitted as part of the Design and Access Statement by the applicant for the original application for the temporary dwelling (P/19/076/COU) was that flood risk did not affect the site because the site was 5 m above sea level.

However, the site of the yurt is actually within both the Flood Zone 2 and Flood Zone 3 extents (see Figure 1 below). The site is subject to flood risk.

The application to extend the period of use for the temporary dwelling notes that flood risk applies to the site of the proposed new permanent dwelling (not part of this application) but does not assess the flood risk applying to the temporary dwelling.

I recommend that the applicant should be asked to undertake a flood risk assessment, and to identify how they will reduce flood risk to an acceptable level for the temporary dwelling during its expected lifetime.
