## Section 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990: Notification of Works to Trees in a Conservation Area

**REFERENCE:** P/23/089/TWA  
**WORKS PROPOSED:** Removal of 1 large branch on 1x mature Elm at Tamarisk which is overhanging Hugh House. Trim back of smaller branches to enhance tree health.  
**LOCATION:** Tamarisk, The Garrison, St Mary's

Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 13<sup>th</sup> November 2023. I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works which have been assessed as appropriate.
