Good afternoon Sam

Thanks for your email.

I have spoken to the fabricators of the timber building this afternoon. They have advised that, as this is going to be a lightweight structure, it will be quite acceptable to loose lay concrete blocks on their flat side to form a strip along both ends of the building. The blocks would be laid on the existing ground simply raked and levelled without any need for excavations. This will also, incidentally, mean that there is virtually no waste to dispose of – but this will be made clear in the waste management plan.

The advantage of this approach is that there will be no potential disturbance of any hidden archaeology.

If you are happy with this I can make reference to the concrete blocks on the application drawings.
