Please identify the tree(s) and provide a full and clear specification of the works you want to carry out

The trees in question are 2 x mature Monterey Pines (pinus radiata) to the North East of the coastal footpath past Juliet's Garden and adjacent to the South Westerly boundary of Pendragon. Both trees are showing signs of windblow, and over-maturity: there is significant dead wood overhanging the public footpath to the South West (creating a potential health and safety issue) and also significant shading and additional deadwood extending over a polythene tunnel structure to the North East which is part of Pendragon's garden.

It is the intention of this application to both preserve the trees and enhance their health and also address the issues outlined above through a removal of deadwood, a crown-lift and reduction and targeted pruning. The works will be carried out by a qualified individual to BS3998. Please see additional attached information for a sketch plan of the trees' location and various photographs.

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.
