Comments:

Ecological Impact Assessment

I agree with the conclusions drawn in the Ecological Impact Assessment report and have no objections on ecological grounds. The report contains recommendations for enhancement of the site and identifies the need for pre-commencement surveys and method statements these should be required as a condition of the development.

A construction and Environmental Management Plan (CEMP) must be prepared prior to any work commencing.

The report identifies the need for walkover surveys to be completed 6 weeks prior to any vegetation clearance to check for the presence of invasive plant species. An Invasive Species Control Plan must be prepared and implemented due to the presence of montbretia, rhododendron and giant gunnera.

A walkover survey must be completed prior to any vegetation clearance work to check for the presence of notable plant species. If any nationally rare or scarce plants are found a method statement will be required for their translocation.

A method statement is required to ensure that works do not impact red squirrel.
