Section 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990: Notification of Works to Trees in a Conservation Area

**REFERENCE** P/25/087/TWA

**WORKS PROPOSED:** Application to trim 1x Beech to reduce width and

provide clearance from property roof; to fell 1x Olearia; prune 3x Holly to allow additional light into the garden; to remove branches to 3x Elm

which are overhanging footpath.

**LOCATION:** 22 Launceston Close, Old Town, St Mary's, Isles

of Scilly, TR21 0NJ.

Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 23 September 2025. Following a site visit of the Council's Planning Officer I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works. Whilst the trees hold good amenity value it is considered that the proposed works are appropriate. The Council do not intend to protect any of the trees through a Tree Preservation Order (TPO).

If the works are not executed within two years of the date of this letter you are required to notify the Council's Planning Department again of your intention to undertake work to the trees. The work should be carried out in accordance with good practice as set out in "British Standards Recommendation for Tree Work" BS3998.
